STAT. § 29-110 Prosecutions; indictment; time limitations</p> <p>(1) For all felonies, indictment must be found by a grand jury within three years after commission of the offense, unless a complaint is filed within three years after commission of the offense, and a warrant for arrest of defendant has been issued</p> <p>(2) For all misdemeanors, indictment must be found within one year and six months after commission of the offense</p> <p>(2) For all misdemeanors for which punishment is restricted by a fine not exceeding \$100 and to imprisonment not exceeding three months, within one year after commission of the offense</p> <p>(5) No limit for:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Sexual assault in the first degree (§ 28-319) • Sexual assault in the second degree (§ 28-320 (2)) • Sexual assault of a child in the first degree (§ 28-319.01) • Sexual assault of a child in the second or third degree (§ 28-320.01) • Sexual assault in the third degree when victim is under 16 at the time of commission of the offense (§ 28-320 (3))
