

Who Must Report?	Any person licensed by the state of Washington to practice
	podiatric medicine and surgery, optometry, chiropractic, nursing, dentistry, osteopathic medicine and surgery, or medicine and surgery or to provide other health services and a duly accredited Christian Science practitioner; County coroner or medical examiner; Law enforcement officer; Professional school personnel, including but not limited to teachers, counselors, administrators, child care facility personnel, and school nurses; Social service counselor; Psychologist; Pharmacist; Licensed or certified child care providers and their employees; Employee of the Washington Department of Social and Health Services and Department of Early Learning; Juvenile probation officer; Placement and liaison specialist; Responsible living skills program staff; HOPE center staff, or state family and children's ombudsman or any volunteer in the ombudsman's office; Any person, in his or her official supervisory capacity with a nonprofit or for-profit organization, has reasonable cause to believe that a child has suffered abuse or neglect caused by a person over whom he or she regularly exercises supervisory authority (note: no one shall be required to report under this section when he or she obtains the information solely as a result of a privileged communication as provided in RCW 5.60.060); Department of corrections personnel who, in the course of their employment, observe offenders or the children with whom the offenders are in contact; and Any adult who has reasonable cause to believe that a child who resides with them, has suffered severe abuse, and is able or capable
	of making a report.

Contents of Report	• The identity of the alleged perpetrator, if known;
Comems of Report	• The name, address, and age of the child;
	• The name and address of the child's parents, stepparents,
	guardians, or other persons having custody of the child;
	• The nature and extent of the alleged injury or injuries;
	The nature and extent of the alleged neglect;
	<ul> <li>The nature and extent of the alleged sexual abuse;</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>Any evidence of previous injuries, including their nature and</li> </ul>
	extent; and

Timing/Other Procedures	<ul> <li>Report must be made immediately.</li> </ul>

	amount fixed by the court of not more than one thousand dollars,
